

## SURREY PRIMARY SCHOOLS CROSS-COUNTRY RACES 2020

<b>VENUE</b>	<b>SATURDAY MARCH 7th at PRIORY PARK, REIGATE</b>
<b>ENTRIES</b>	<p>Entries are invited from any State or Independent School with children registered in Years 5 and 6, deemed to be within the Geographical areas of Rural Surrey, or in the London Boroughs of Merton, Croydon, Sutton and Kingston.</p> <p><b>Please note: This event is for Years 5 and 6 only. Entries can only be accepted from authorised school staff.</b></p> <p><b>There are NO races for Year 4 and Year 4s CANNOT run in Year 5 teams.</b></p> <p>There will be separate races for Boys and Girls in Year 5 and 6.</p> <p><b>Each school may enter a maximum of 8 (eight) runners in each race</b></p> <p>The Entry Fee is £3 per runner.</p> <p>All entries are to made ONLINE and the system is now live. Schools will have to register to use the system. Details are in an Entry Guide, downloaded from the SSAA website.</p> <p>The <b>CLOSING DATE WILL BE SATURDAY FEBRUARY 29th at 22.00</b> The Entries website will then be blocked.</p>
<b>RACE TIMINGS</b>	<p>It is anticipated that the Race timings will be:</p> <p><b>11.00: Year 5 Girls</b></p> <p><b>11.40: Year 5 Boys</b></p> <p><b>12.10: Year 6 Girls</b></p> <p><b>13.00: Year 6 Boys</b></p> <p>Should there be a repeat of the numbers we have had in recent years, it will be necessary to split the race (e.g. Year 5 Girls) into two races for reasons of Health &amp; Safety. Information about the number of races and who is in which race will be published on the SSAA website after entries close.</p>
<b>COURSE</b>	All races will be of the same distance (2.2 km). There is a link to the course map at the top of this page and it can also be downloaded from the SSAA website.
<b>PAYMENT</b>	Payment for Entries is also being done ONLINE, using a payment system called STRIPE, with a Debit or Credit Card. There will be no bank transfer or cheque payments accepted.
<b>RESULTS</b>	<b>Please note that although the results will contain times and placings, this is no longer regarded as a Primary Schools Championship.</b> Where there is more than one race in an age/gender category there will be no outright winners so best performances will be determined by comparing race times.
